TL;DR As you see in the following line, it is a C# Keylogger! My question is: Is that something you would expect, if you are not a professional programmer? A: This could definitely happen if you're sloppy. As you know, when developing software for Windows the chances of creating a KeyLogger are very high. It's also not that common. So maybe you were just lucky. When I was in college I had to implement a KeyLogger for a project. It was a radio controlled car. I just used built-in functionality of Microsoft's winsock library. I think that it's not that hard to implement. Yes, you need to know C# quite well, but that's not a lot. KeyLoggers are pretty cool, but I don't think of them as something you can get from a free download like a trojan. You shouldn't be too worried about a keylogger. I'm not a security expert and this is a general answer, but the general rule is: Be careful what you download. Don't install things from random websites. Don't click on every ad that pops up. Check the URL. Don't install programs you don't understand. You're not supposed to be an expert, but you can be an expert in one subject.
